







To maintain accreditation, the levee owner or community is required to submit the data and documentation neccessary to comply with Section 65.10 of the NFIP regulations by 8/30/2020. If the community or owner does not provide the necessary data and documentation or if the data and documentation provided indicate the levee system does not comply with Section 65.10 requirements, FEMA will revise the flood hazard and risk information for this area to reflect de-accreditation of the levee system. To mitigate flood risk in residual risk areas, property owners and residents are engouraged to consider flood insurance and floodproofing or other protective measures.
