GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Definition. This permit is issued under County Ordinance No. 20 and amendments thereto.
2. Safety of Other Traffic. Permittee shall at all times give strict attention to the safety and right of the traveling public.
3. Yield Right of Way. When being passed by vehicles traveling in either direction, no portion of equipment or trailers shall extend beyond the center line of pavement or traveled way.
4. Protection on Bridges or Narrow Roads. When crossing bridges or on roads so narrow that it is impossible to comply with paragraph 3 one man shall be posted behind and one man ahead of such equipment to warn and direct approaching traffic.
5. Protect Asphaltic Pavement. Whenever heavy equipment with steel tires or a structure is to be moved over asphaltic type pavement between May 1st and October 1st, it is to be moved before 9 a.m. or after 5 p.m.
6. Night Moving. If any moving is permitted at night, necessary warning lights must be displayed and flag men employed in such a manner as to thoroughly protect traffic in either direction. Night moving is not permitted unless specifically so started on the face thereof.
7. Moving in Foggy or Rainy Weather. No moving shall be done in foggy or rainy weather either day or night except on special authorization.
8. Parking on Highway. If necessary to park equipment or to leave a structure on the highway at night, it shall be moved off the traveled way or pavement so as not to interfere in any way with passing traffic. Warning lights shall be displayed so as to fully protect said traffic.
9. No Moving During Heavy Traffic. Equipment or structure covered by this permit shall not be moved over the highways on Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays unless specifically so stated on the face hereof.
10. Responsibility for Bridges. This permit does not authorize crossing any posted bridges with gross load exceeding posted limits unless specifically mentioned on the face of this permit. Permittee shall comply with all rules posted on any bridges over which he shall pass and shall assume all risks relative thereto.
11. Overhead Clearances. When height or load exceeds 12'6" it becomes the responsibility of the permittee to check all underpasses, bridges, overhead wires or other structure for impaired vertical clearance and to bypass or arrange clearance at such locations.
12. Permit Subject to Inspection. The permit must be carried on the equipment or structure at all times while it is being moved within the highway limits. It shall be submitted for inspection on demand of an authorized employee of the Roads Department or any law enforcement officer. Legibility of the permit is the responsibility of the Permittee. Illegible permits are subject to enforcement action.
13. Repair of Damage. In accepting this permit, the permittee agrees to repair at his own expense and to the satisfaction of the Roads Department, any damage to the highway or structures. Work or repair may be done by Roads Department forces at the option of the Roads Department Director. The cost is to be borne by the permittee.
14. Liability for Damage. The permittee is responsible for all liability for personal injury or property damages which may occur through any act or omission of the permittee when acting under this permit, and in the event any claim is made against the County of Kern or any department, officer, or employee thereof, through, by reason of or in connection with any such act or omission, the permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold them and each of them harmless from such claim. This permit shall not be effective for any purpose unless and until the above named permittee files with the Roads Department, an insurance certificate in the form and amount required by said department, unless specifically exempted on the face hereof.
15. Time Limit. Unless specifically stated on the face hereof this permit is good for only one trip between the points designated and used before time and date shown on face of the permit.
16. Comply With Applicable Laws. Except as specifically provided herein, the requirements of the California Vehicle Code and any other applicable laws must be complied with in all particulars.
17. Limit of Authorization. This permit only covers portions of moves on County Highways under maintenance by the Roads Department, State and/or City permits must be secured for travel on roads and streets under respective jurisdiction.
18. Acceptance of Permit. The moving of any load on the highway in accordance with this permit shall be regarded as an acceptance by the permittee of all terms and conditions of the permit.
19. Legibility of permit This permit shall be null and void if any portion or section is illegible or altered in any form.
20. Moving in convoy Movement in convoy shall not be permitted unless specifically stated on permit.

Weight and Size of Loads

21. Limit of Load. The weight or size of load shall be within the limit stated on the face of this permit.
22. Maximum Weight and Size. The maximum limit for weight and size of vehicles and loads set forth in the California Vehicle Code shall not be exceeded except as specifically stated on the face of this permit.

Buildings and Other Structures

23. Kind of Equipment. Buildings are to be moved with regular house moving equipment.
24. Interference With Traffic. The moving shall be done at the time of day and in a manner which will cause the least interference with traffic.
25. Cleaning Up Right of Way. Upon completion of the moving work, all timbers and equipment shall be removed and the right of way left in the same condition as before the work started.
26. Do Not Disturb Roadway Surface. No wedge, bar or spike shall be driven in the surface of the County highway.
27. Care of Trees. No trees shall be cut, trimmed, used for attaching cable or in any way disturbed.
28. Care of Overhead Lines. Permittee must notify the owner of all overhead lines subject to disturbance or damage by his operations at least twenty-four hours in advance of such work and mutually agreeable arrangements shall be made between the parties affected. This provision does not authorize owners of overhead lines to limit work allowed under this permit.
